





THE BEGINNING OF WISDOM




But the wisdom that comes from heaven is

good fruit, impartial and sincere.



²⁷ The one who has knowledge uses words with restraint, and whoever has understanding is even-tempered.


²⁸ Even fools are thought wise if they keep silent, and discerning if they hold their tongues.
