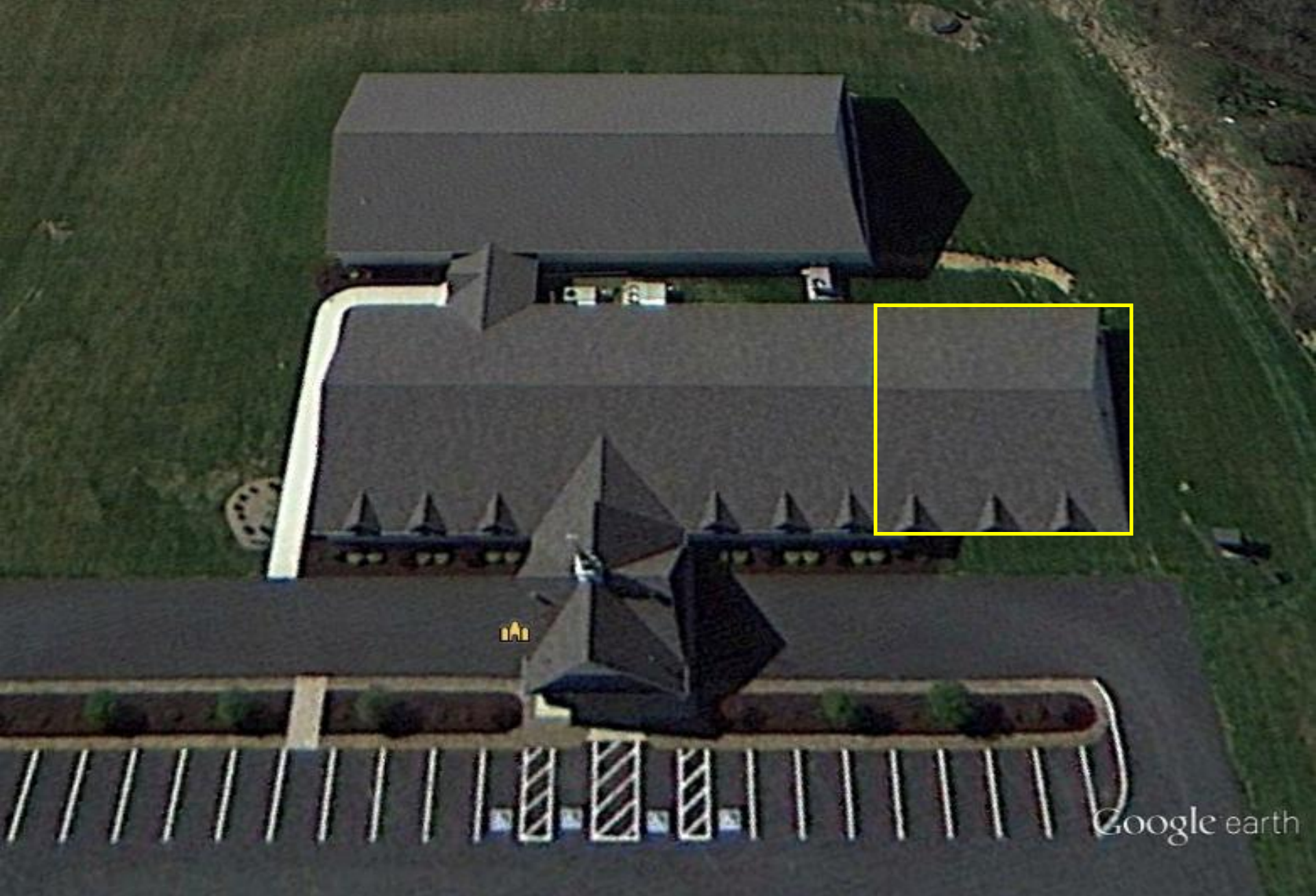


Current Parking: 72 Spaces

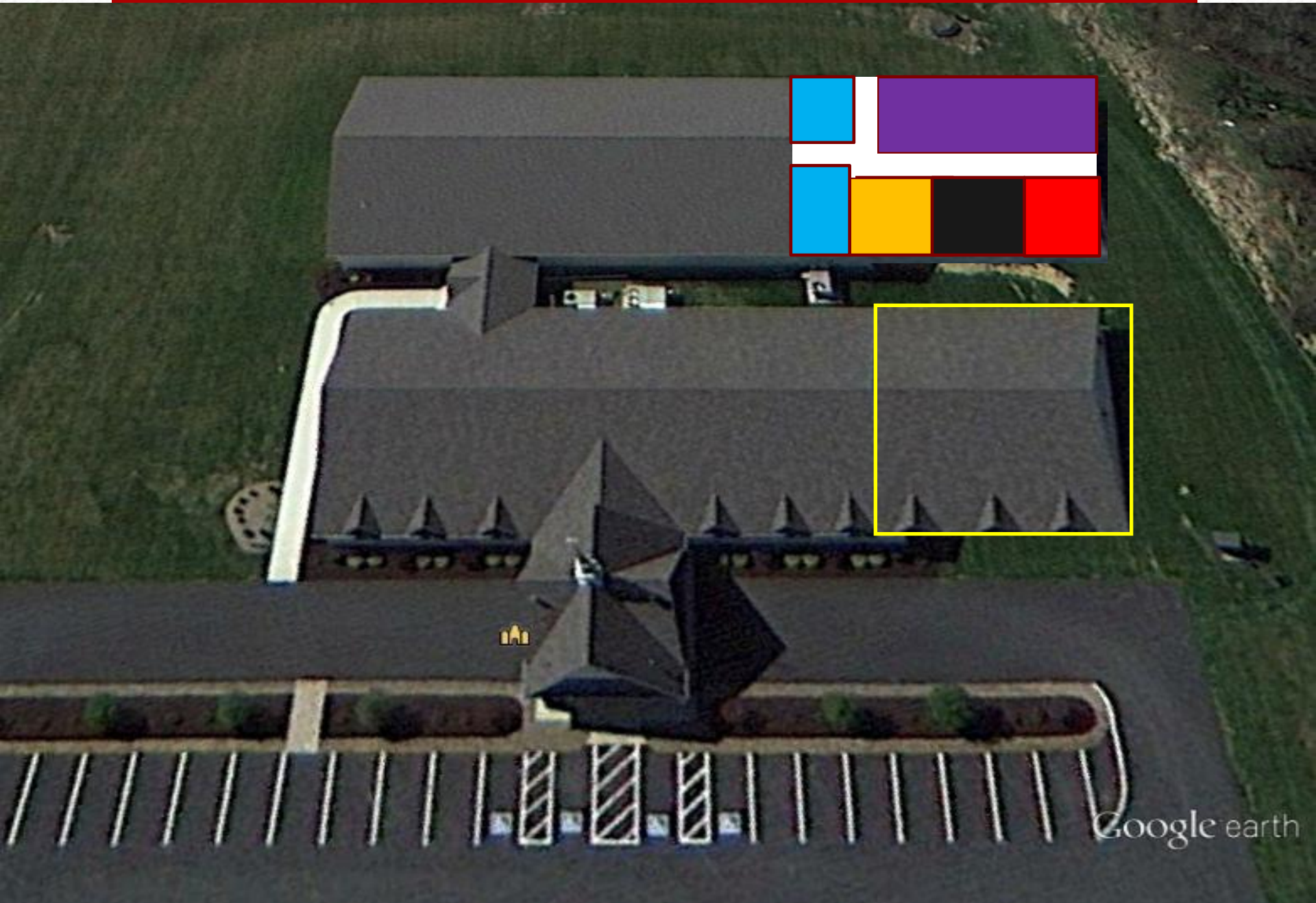


Parking Lot Expansion (120 Spaces), Fill Ditch, Seal Coat

- Building Fund: \$29,000.00
- Approximate General Fund Available: \$41,000.00
- Total Approximate Available Funds: \$70,000.00
- Lot Finished: \$20,500.00
- Architect Fees: Estimated at \$15,000.00
- **Left for Building Project: \$34,500.00**
